For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea. ² They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. 3 They all ate the same

spiritual food ⁴ and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ.

⁵ Nevertheless, God was not pleased with most of them; their bodies were scattered in the wilderness.





- They <u>presumed</u> on God's mercy.

- They presumed on God's mercy.
- They trivialized sin and its consequences.
- They pushed God's patience to the limit.

⁶ Now these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did.







Four Specific Areas...

A. Idolatry

⁷ Do not be idolaters, as some of them were; as it is written: "The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in revelry."







B. Sexual Immorality

⁸ We should not commit sexual immorality, as some of them did—and in one day twenty-three thousand of them died.







C. Testing God

⁹ We should not test Christ, as some of them did—and were killed by snakes.

D. Grumbling

¹⁰ And do not grumble, as some of them did —and were killed by the destroying angel.
