1 Corinthians 14



¹ Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy.³... the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort.



 Prophecy is open to the <u>entire</u> church and is something to pursue with eagerness.



2. You probably <u>believe</u> in prophecy though you may not use that terminology.



3. When you think prophecy, don't think foretelling, rather think <u>forthtelling</u>.



4. Definition: speaking what <u>God brings</u> to your mind for the strengthening, encouraging and comfort of fellow believers

1 Corinthians 14:29-33



²⁹ Two or three prophets should speak, and the others should weigh carefully what is said. ³⁰ And if a revelation comes to someone who is sitting down, the first speaker should stop. ³¹ For you can all prophesy in turn so that everyone may be instructed and encouraged.

1 Corinthians 14:29-33



³² The spirits of prophets are subject to the control of prophets. ³³ For God is not a God of disorder but of peace—as in all the congregations of the Lord's people.



5. The prophecy of the NT is <u>not</u> the same thing as the prophets in the OT.

6. The NT clearly teaches that we are to weigh and evaluate prophecy.

1 Thessalonians 5:19-22



¹⁹ Do not quench the Spirit. ²⁰ Do not treat prophecies with contempt ²¹ but test them all; hold on to what is good, ²² reject every kind of evil.



7. Prophecy played a <u>vital role</u> in the life of the early church and it can today as well.



8. The abuse and misuse of anything should not lead us to <u>no use</u>.

1 Corinthians 14: 34-35



³⁴ Women should remain silent in the churches. They are not allowed to speak, but must be in submission, as the law says. ³⁵ If they want to inquire about something, they should ask their own husbands at home; for it is disgraceful for a woman to speak in the church.

1 Corinthians 14:36-38



³⁶ Or did the word of God originate with you? Or are you the only people it has reached? ³⁷ If anyone thinks they are a prophet or otherwise gifted by the Spirit, let them acknowledge that what I am writing to you is the Lord's command. ³⁸ But if anyone ignores this, they will themselves be ignored.

1 Corinthians 14:39-40



³⁹ Therefore, my brothers and sisters, be eager to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in tongues. ⁴⁰ But everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way.



God wants to strengthen, encourage and comfort other believers through <u>your words</u>.
